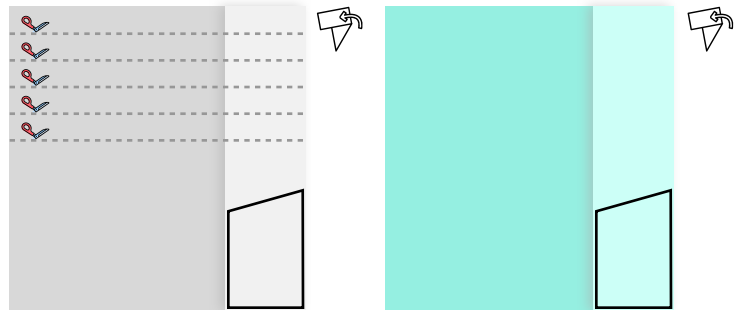


Materials

1 or 2 — 18" x 22" Fat Quarters

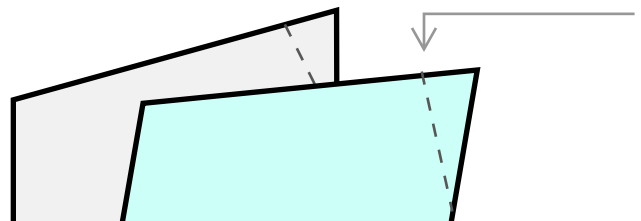
Instructions

Cut one mask panel from each fat quarter by folding the fabric and using the pattern on page 3.

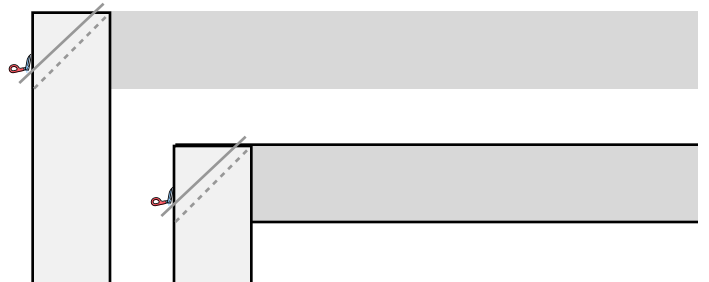


Cut five 1.5" x 22" strips from one or both of the fat quarters

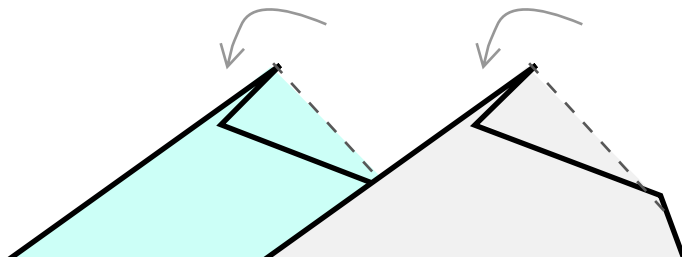
Using the pattern, draw a pencil line and sew the nose gusset for both mask panels on the inside of the fabric.



With the outsides facing, join the 22" strips by sewing a diagonal. Do this for four of the strips. You will have one left over. Trim the excess.

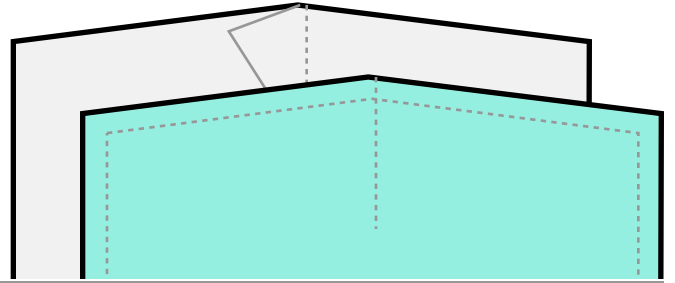


Fold and iron the nose gusset for both mask panels (same direction). Iron all of the strips to create bias tape (using a guide or by folding sides in and then folding in half).

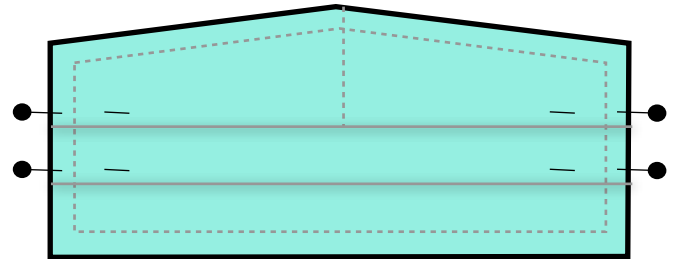


Instructions, Cont.

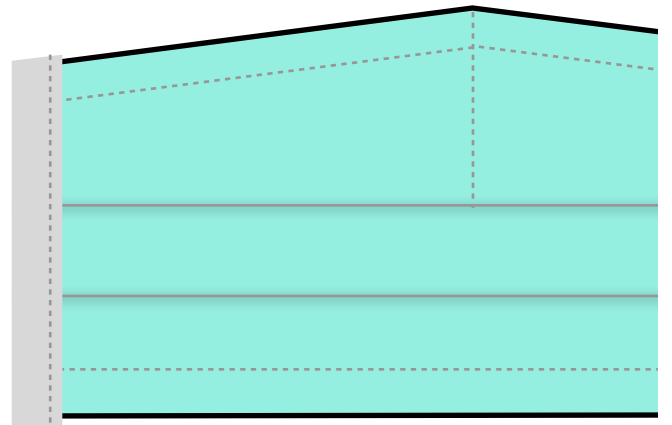
Pin the mask panels together and sew a 0.25" border all of the way around.



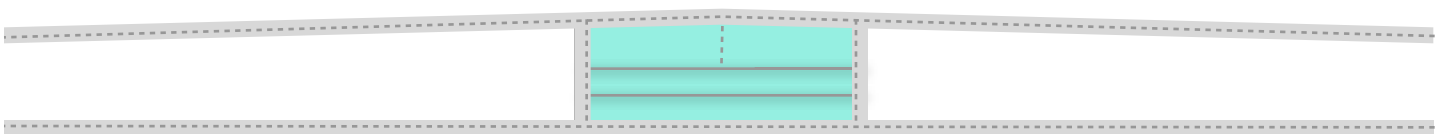
Pin and sew pleats at the marks on the mask panel pattern. After pinning, the mask height should measure 3" on the edges.



If needed, trim down the borders so the bias tape will cover the seams. Beginning with the sides, sew bias tape onto each seam. The joined strips are meant for the top and bottom of the mask to create ties. These strips should be centered on the mask panels.
